

Pennant Hills Summer Soccer FAQs 2019

What age groups do you have competitions in?

We are expecting to have competitions in all age groups as listed on the website pennofc.com.au except perhaps some of the ladies competitions which may be merged.

What day and times will games occur?

Game days are listed on the website. Play for U6-U11 is expected to be from 5-7pm. Play for U12-U17 between 6-8pm and Senior teams between 7-10pm.

Season length

10 straight weeks as per website, rain hail or shine....

How do I register.

First step is to gather your players and then register your team. Once your team has been approved then we will provide instructions for individual players to register on Myfootballclub.com.au website.

Team strip?

Teams need to supply their own playing strip in terms of shirt, shorts and socks. Numbered shirts are best but numbered bibs can be worn. There is a common sense approach to shirt logo's and team names. Nothing inappropriate please. If in doubt ask before buying your gear.

Payments

Team registration payments may be Cash, cheque or EFT, player registration payments on-line and team match payments cash or electronic on game-day.

If teams prefer match payments can be made in bulk in advance for the season by EFT.

Number of players per team?

There are no limits on number of Players registered in each team but there are limits to those on the field at one time – unlimited interchange in all ages.

4 a side for 6/7 age groups,

5 a side for all other age groups

except

AA Premier League who will play 6 a side.

Player numbers are unlimited but must be registered. Rolling subs throughout games.

We almost have a team but need one or two more players?

We can host a list of teams requiring extra players on the Pennant Hills Football Club facebook and home web-pages. We will also keep a register with contact details. We will direct players as and if they become available.

I can't form a team but would like to play?

Different to Winter Club Football, this competition is designed to be a 'bring a team option'. But we will take your details and endeavour to put you in contact with any team needing players.

I would like to play in more than one team?

You can play in more than one team as long as they are in different competitions.

How long is each game?

Each game consists of two halves which are:

12 mins halves for U6-11,

15 mins halves for U12-15

20 minutes halves for U16-seniors

Do we need a goalkeeper?

Goalkeepers only required for U8 and above

Can I be a referee and earn some money?

Yes we are looking for current qualified referees for all age groups

Yes, we are looking for young players interested in refereeing junior games.

We will provide supervision and training to our youngest trainee referees between the ages of 11 and 15 who will referee the age groups U/6 through to U/13.

We are also keen to create a roster of currently registered referees to control the older junior teams and senior games.
